POLICY STATEMENT  
SCHOOL UNIFORM**

At Brewood CE (C) Middle School we believe that wearing a school uniform is very important in maintaining high standards and identifies pupils as members of our school community. This policy is fair to all pupils and will be strictly followed at all times.

Uniform should be worn smartly ie. Blazer sleeves down, ties at a standard length, shirts tucked in etc.

Our school uniform is as follows and we ask parents / carers to ensure that all items are named.

**Girls**

Black skirt or black trousers (No leggings/skin tight trsrs)  
White school blouse which tucks in  
House tie \*  
School sweatshirt or cardigan (optional) \*  
White / black socks to below the knee / opaque  
Black tights  
Black shoes with low heels  
NOT 'trainers, boots, sandals or canvas shoes  
Black Blazer with school badge \*

**Boys**

Black trousers  
(Not 'cords' or jeans)  
White shirt  
House Tie \*  
School sweatshirt (optional) \*  
Grey / black socks  
Black shoes not 'trainers', canvas shoes or boots  
Black Blazer with school badge \*

**SUMMER**

**Girls**

Dress in green/white stripes/check  
alternatively girls may wear short-sleeved blouses  
with house tie  
Black skirt / trousers  
Black shoes with low heels (not open toes, canvas  
shoes or sling backs)  
Black Blazer with school badge \*  
White ankle socks

**P. E. Girls**

White 'T' shirt / polo shirt \*  
Plain black shorts \*  
Gym or training shoes  
Bottle green P E socks \*  
School green / gold Rugby shirt \*  
Black Sports leggings

**P. E. Boys**

Black Top\*  
Plain black shorts \*  
Black P E socks \*  
Gym or training shoes  
Shin guards  
School green / gold Rugby shirt or black fleece \*

In addition to the uniform list above we have expectations regarding jewellery and make up, if these are not followed Form Teachers will send letters home to parents / carers.

- If you a parent / carer wishes their child to wear an earring only **ONE** gold or silver stud should be worn in each ear. It would help if ear piercing was done at the start of the Summer holidays in order for healing to take place before the new academic year begins. There should be **NO** other body piercing.
- **No other form of jewellery is allowed to be worn in school (including wrist bands etc).**
- **No make up, eyebrow or eyelash tinting or fake tan.**
- **No nail varnish or acrylic nails are allowed.** These may cause harm to other pupils in contact activities and may prevent pupils from carrying out normal school activities.
- **No hair extensions or dyed hair.**

**Staffordshire County's Physical Education Policy is as follows:**
