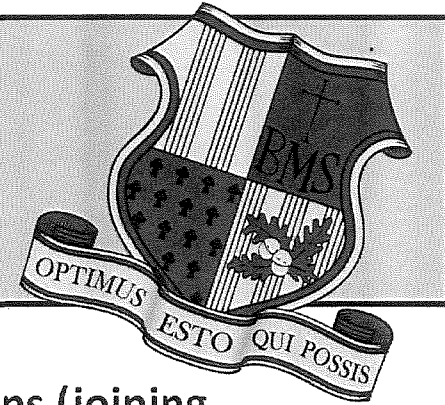


Week 3 and 4: Sentences



There are 3 main types of sentences:

Simple

Compound

Complex

It's important to vary the types of sentences you use in order to make your writing more interesting to read.

Simple: I like science lessons. I always do well.

Compound: I like science lessons because I always do well.

Complex: When my science teacher gave me back my homework, I was thrilled that she had given me a merit.
