#### ANNUAL SPORTS DAY - Friday June 23<sup>rd</sup> 2017

I am writing to inform you about this year's Sports Day which will take place on the school sports field on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> June. (We will monitor the weather forecast closely and do our best to proceed although the safety of the pupils will always come first - a reserve day has been agreed as Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> June).

The first event is due to start at 9.40am and we will endeavour to stick as closely as possible to the times listed in the programme which will go on sale for 50p each lunchtime and on Sports Day as you enter the field. The programme will tell you the approximate time of your child's event, whom they are competing against and the current school record.

On the day, pupils are asked to arrive at school in their correct P.E kit. Please ensure that pupils do wear school kit and not their own interpretation of school kit! For those of you who have not visited our school field it may be worth mentioning that there is very little shade from the sun or shelter from the rain so check the forecast and come prepared! **All visitors will be asked to sign in/out at the entrance to the field and to wear a visitor's badge whilst on site.**

Drinks and healthy snack items will be on sale on the school field so pupils may wish to bring a small amount of money with them which will be their responsibility during the day.

This year, pupils will be sitting on a chair in **year group blocks** rather than in House areas and they will be asked to remain in these areas unless they are competing, visiting the toilet or fruit/water stall. As in previous years, pupils are allowed to bring sun shades/umbrellas to use in the case of very sunny/showery conditions. Tents are not allowed and dogs are not permitted on the school field.

#### Behaviour

We always expect excellent behaviour from our pupils and Sports Day is often a memorable occasion for lots of our pupils and parents. In the unlikely event that a pupil chooses to misbehave to an extent that it compromises the safety and/or enjoyment of others, we will ask for parents to collect their child from school.


#### Lunchtime arrangements
